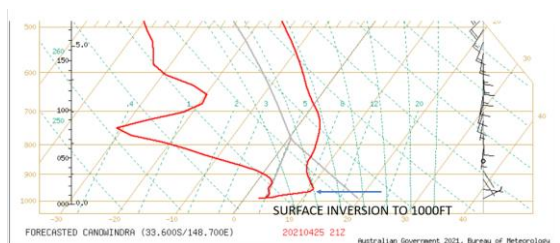
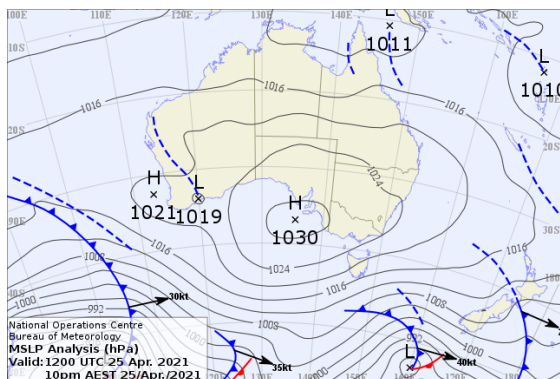




Weather Briefing, Monday

26th April 2021 Valid 0630 - 1000

Situation: A high pressure system in the Bight extends a ridge across New South Wales. Stable conditions with light winds. Sunny.



SURFACE WIND: 040/04kt.

WEATHER: Frost. Fog patches then sunny.

CLOUD: Nil significant.

VISIBILITY: 1000m in fog otherwise 20km.

TURB: Nil significant.

TEMP: 01c rising to 14c by 1000. Max 20c.

AREA QNH: 1025.

SUNRISE. 0636.

REMARKS: Local drainage below 1000ft until 0900.
