Protest by competitor ZO (Peter Gregory).

I am not satisfied and do not agree with your response to my complaint regarding Task 6. (complaint dated 07th August 2022 at 22:45).

As declared at general and Supplementary briefings, all PZs are in force, as published in the rules according to Rule 7.3. The director has declared this airspace as prohibited.

Rule 7.5 states "A competitor violating a PZ in force will be penalised by up to 1000 competition points proportional to the offence".

In order to attain a better score in Task 6, violating rule 7.5 was done by some competitors.

To avoid losing competition points and violating areas prohibited, (as set out by the director), I did not feel able to compete in this task and was disadvantaged unfairly.

The direction of GPS loggers is stated in general briefing (II. 17 & 16,10)

The decision of the director to not utilise GPS track data from the BLS system was ambiguous in the supplementary briefing.

This should not have taken precedent over rule 7.5 and its ability to be enforced.

I request that if task 6 is not able to be scored in accordance with the rules, the task should be declared invalid.
