II. 23 COMPETITION STRUCTURE (6.1)

The competition will be conducted using Target team's measurements and logger scoring.

Additional notes:

- Task scores are considered published when they have been posted on the ENB as "Official". Measuring lists and "Provisional" scores are not considered to be "task scores".
- Launch masters will not be used.

During briefings:
