4.3 Duties of the international Jury

4.3.1 MATTERS OF ARBITRATION OR RULE INTERPRETATION SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE FAI JURY MEMBERS. ~~FAI OFFICIALS ARE APPOINTED BY THE CIA AND ARE ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE FAI. (GS 5.2.1 part)~~

The Jury President is appointed by the Ballooning Commission of the Aeroclub of Poland. The other 2 Jury members are appointed in the General Briefing, one from the competitors and one from the officials. In case a Jury member is involved in a protest, another competitors or official will replace in this matter.

9.14 Launch masters

Launch masters will not be used unless otherwise stated in the task briefing.

10.2 Dangerous flying

Limit checking does not change any manufacturer's limitations. Any limits indicated in the flight manual still apply.

12.4 Target

The target will normally be displayed within 100m of the given goal coordinates, as close as possible to the coordinates.

12.5 Marker

All available markers have been distributed. You must keep the markers after each flight and you are responsible for bringing them to be used in all upcoming flights.

Dropped and measured markers will be redistributed by the officials at the next briefing. Therefore you must check that your dropped markers have been collected by the measuring teams.

12.16 Marker measuring area

12.16.1 If not otherwise stated in the TDS, the MMA has a radius of 50m.
