I have declared a valid goal on per the task data, in particular part C of the task,

declared goal with co-ordinates and altitude.

Rule 12.3.6 sets out that if a declaration

may be made in flight - before a defined time, point or boundary - and the competitor

fails to do so, the declaration will be invalid.

I have been penalised and given a no result due to the difference in height between

declaration and the goal. This was set out in Part D of the task data, which specified that there must be a difference of 500ft

between declaration and goal altitude.

Rule 12.3.7 sets out that goals not meeting distance or relative altitude limitations will

be scored according to the rule on distance boundaries or absolute altitude limits

will be invalid.


I am appealing that on the basis of rule

12.3.7, I should have been scored according to the rule on distance infringements instead

of receiving a no result.

Therefore, I would like to rely on declaring a valid goal and that only distance ~~is~~ infringements should have been applied to my

score, runner man a no result, due to  
being within 500 feet between ~~the~~  
deceleration and goal altitude.
