



Power Line Accident Procedure

We request all the pilots to pay maximum attention to the power lines. But if your balloon happens to touch a power line, you have to contact an official **“IMMEDIATELY” even if there seems no damage on the line.** If the pilot is unable to make a contact, ask the ground crew to do so.

If it is a serious accident, refer to the other document “Emergency Procedure” and follow the instruction.

When you make a report, please make sure you get the following information:

- Location (take the GPS co-ordinates of the accident point)
- Time of the accident
- Situation of injury of pilot, crew or third persons, damage of the electric line, the balloon damage.

We also need to get this as additional information. When you go back to the accident site, call again to submit it.

- Sequence numbers of the electric poles where the contact point is in between. (marked on the pole)
