


Weather Briefing 0515 Monday 4th September 2023 Valid 0600-1000

Situation: A high pressure ridge is directing a westerly airstream across Western Australia. A cold front to the south will produce isolated showers and drizzle during the morning.



SURFACE WIND: 290/05-07kts.

WEATHER: Isolated drizzle/showers.

CLOUD: BKN 3000ft. SCT 1200ft.

VISIBILITY: 4000m showers otherwise.


