


Weather Briefing 0515 Wednesday 6th September 2023 Valid 0600-1000

Situation: A cold front just to the east of Northam is moving rapidly eastwards as a high pressure system builds to the west. Gusty southwesterly winds in the wake of the front will persist during the morning.



SURFACE WIND: 230/05-08kts.

WEATHER: Isolated showers.

CLOUD: BKN 2500ft. SCT 1500ft.

VISIBILITY: 5000m showers
